They were also able to take two children from one of the orphanages for a fun day of shopping and bowling.

Mission to the Son’s primary 2018 goal is to raise enough money through fundraising and donations to purchase a multi-purpose home in the area in which they stayed. This facility will be used as housing during mission trips, but will have enough space to also be utilized as a nursing home, a home for families who cannot afford one, or a school. They met with a realtor in Montego Bay and visited several homes they are interested in.

“Most people think of Jamaica as a luxurious place to vacation, but many of the residents live in desperate conditions,” stated Stephanie Kline, President & Founder. “These individuals and families do not have the resources to help them survive that we sometimes take for granted in America.”
